


I. Feudalism A. Social Pyramid

I. Feudalism is the legal and social system that existed in medieval Europe, in which vassals held land from lords in exchange for military service.


 Based on the trade of land and service in return for loyalty.






- King distributed land (fiefs) to trusted friends and family making them Lords.
- 2. In return the Lords, or vassals, would lead troops in the kings army.
- Knights were given land by the lords in return for manning the armies.
- Serfs were forced to work the land in return for protection from barbarians and enemy lords.
