

- est. 750,000 killed, missing or wounded
- 91,000 captured
- Aircraft: 900 (including 274 transports and 165 bombers used as transports)
- Total: 841,000 casualties

#### RUSSIANS

- 478,741 killed or missing
- 650,878 wounded and sick
- 40,000 civilians dead
- 4,341 tanks
- 15,728 guns and mortars
- 2,769 combat aircraft <sup>[8]</sup>
- Total: 1,129,619 casualties


