

First of all I must say something to those who have written to my wife or myself in these last weeks to tell us of their gratitude for my efforts and to assure us of their prayers for my success. Most of these letters have come from women ..., and it has been heartbreaking to read of the growing anxiety they reveal and their intense relief when they thought, too soon, that the danger of war was past.

...How horrible, fantastic, incredible it is that we should be digging trenches and trying on gas masks here because of a quarrel in a far-away country...

However much we may sympathize with a small nation confronted by a big and powerful neighbor, we cannot in all circumstances undertake to involve the whole British Empire in war simply on her account....but if I were convinced that any nation had made up its mind to dominate the world by fear of its force, I should feel that it must be resisted... but war is a fearful thing, and we must be very clear, before we embark upon it...

...there is always hope that it may be prevented, and you know that I am going to work for peace to the last moment. Good night.


