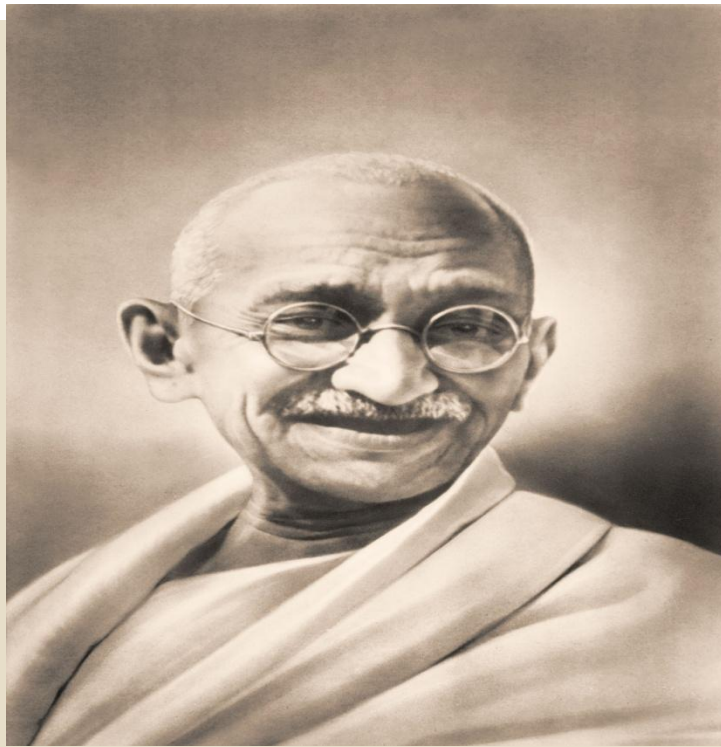

# **IV. 1919 Government of India Act**

- 1. Introduced a national parliament with two houses for India.**
- 2. About 5 million of the wealthiest Indians were given the right to vote**
- 3. Within the provincial governments, ministers of education, health and public works could now be Indian nationals**
- 4. The act planned for a commission to be held in 1929, to see if India was ready for more concessions/reforms.**

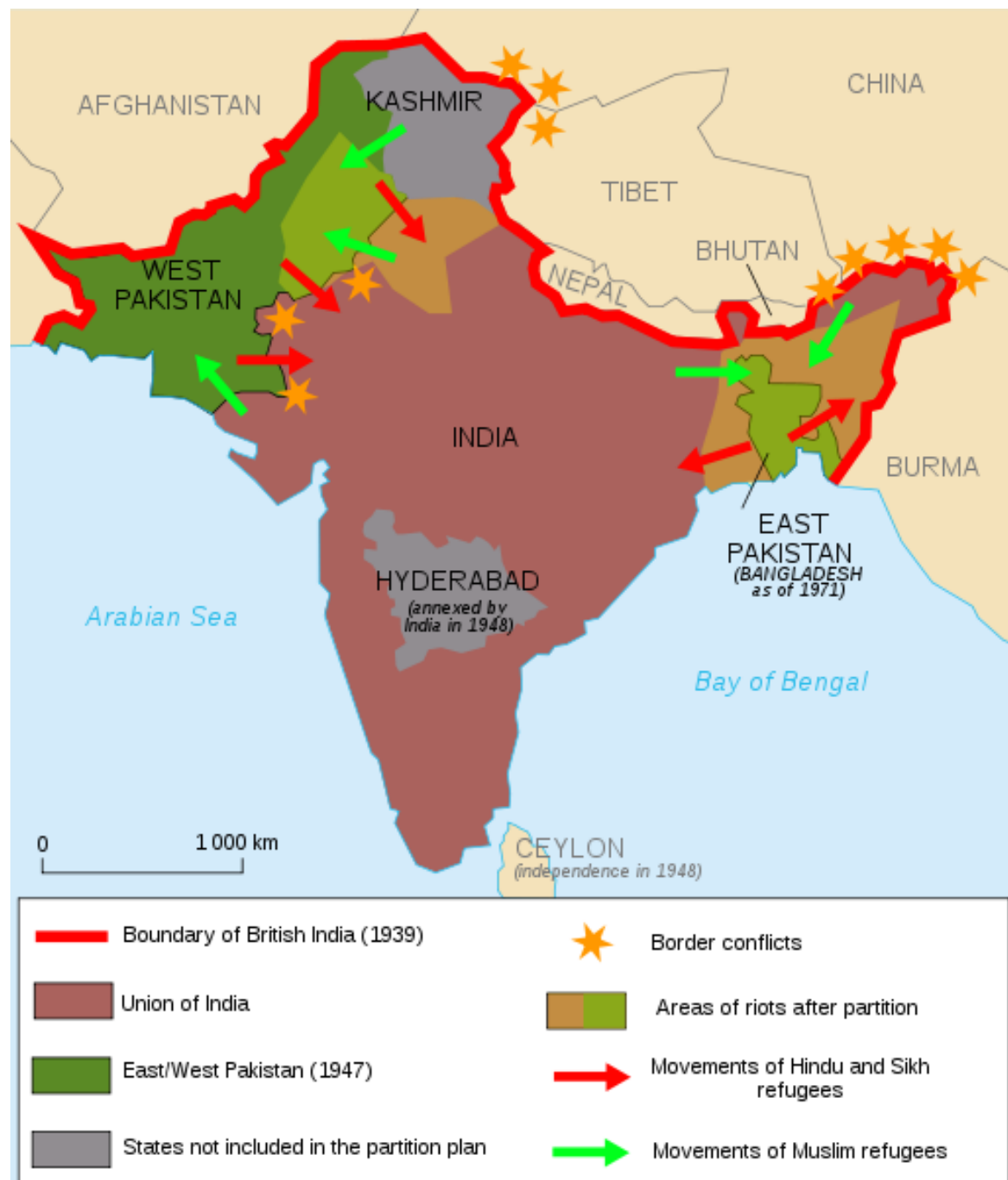
